SURGERY FINAL 2015

Students are kindly informed that the dates of the **written Final exam of Surgery III in 2014/2015 summer period** are:

May 19,	9.00 or 11.00am
May 26,	9.00 or 11.00am
June 2,	9.00 or 11.00am
June 9,	9.00 or 11.00am
June 23,	9.00 or 11.00am

The prerequisites of the application for the Surgery Final are the semester signature and having passed 'Surgery I' semi-final examination.

Applicants must apply for date via NEPTUN! The application process is closed on the previous working day before the exam date by 10am (see 2013/2014. Student guide, page 17).

This is the student's responsibility to show up at Surgery Lecture Hall on time! Nothing but writing facility (pen) can be possessed during exam (especially no cell phones or head sets!).

The written final exam consists of **3 sections**: the **1st part** contains 10, projector displayed, multiple choice, case based questions illustrated by picture(s). Sixty seconds will be provided per question, thus the section takes 10 minutes. Right afterwards, the **2nd part** will come up with 80, projector displayed, multiple choice questions based on all fields of the veterinary surgery material taught. Forty five seconds will be given for each question, thus this section takes 60 minutes. Right afterwards, the **3rd part** will be sacrificed for re-checking the answers one by one providing 15 seconds each for taking a short look at all the 10+80 questions in order to make corrections, thus this section lasts 22.5 minutes. After the approximately 93-minute examination no more possibility of checking the questions will be provided! The answers must be given on the answering sheet containing the student's name and code.

The result of the exam will be advertised in the NEPTUN!

As advertised earlier, extra points will be added to the test result according to the lecture attendance list checked during Surgery 2 and 3 semesters.

The exam is not passed and evaluated as grade 1 if student does not show up on time and in case of not reaching the minimal point requirement of grade 2 level.
